

## Instructions to CET-2021 Karnataka Candidates - UG NEET-2021

Date: 11-12-2021

- The candidates who have already registered for UGCET-2021 and completed the document verification, have to enter their correct UGNEET-2021 Roll Number through online in the KEA Web-portal **from 2.00 pm on 13-12-2021 to 17-12-2021 upto 11.59 pm** to become eligible for admission to Medical, Dental and AYUSH courses, but they need not pay the registration fee once again, further they should check the NEET Roll number printed on the Application Form after entering the UGNEET – 2021 Roll Number.
- Candidates, who have assigned ranks in UGCET-2021 and completed their document verification as per CET-2006 Admission Rules, and those who are not claiming any additional reservation need not appear for verification of documents once again for Medical / Dental / AYUSH courses. But they have to download the UGNEET-2021 Verification slip from KEA portal on the specified dates to become eligible for admission to Medical / Dental courses.
- However, if any such candidate is eligible to claim reservation as per Government of Karnataka norms or Linguistic Minority or Religious Minority or NRI ward seats or candidates eligible to claim seats under Category-2 to Category-8 in St. John Medical College, Bangalore, then they have to claim such reservations in the online application form and they have to appear for document verification with such relevant certificates / documents.
- Further, candidates who have already claimed Linguistic Minority /Religious Minority / NRI WARD in the UGCET-2021 application should also appear for document verification with all the relevant original certificates / documents.
- Karnataka candidates who have not registered for UGCET-2021, but qualified in UGNEET 2021, they have to first register through online at KEA Web-portal, enter all the details, pay the registration fee and appear for verification of documents with all the original relevant certificates at KEA, Bangalore as per the schedule notified.
- Candidates who have registered and filled the online application, paid the registration fees for CET-2021, but not appeared for verification of documents due to non-obtaining of rank for any discipline in CET-2021, if they qualified in UGNEET 2021, then they have to appear with all the original relevant certificates as per the notified schedule to become eligible for admission to Medical / Dental / AYUSH courses.

Special Note: Government share of AYUSH seats will be allotted only to Karnataka candidates.
